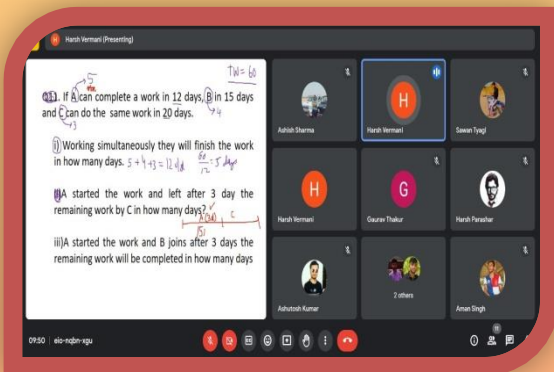

## ❖ Anti Ragging Committee

### **Introduction**

University Has Constituted the Anti Ragging Committee. The following instructions are framed to prevent the menace of ragging and foster healthy interpersonal relations among students in the University. Ragging is strictly forbidden in or outside the University. All students shall familiarize themselves with rules/regulations/guidelines on code of conduct, anti-ragging measures and discipline College. All ‘new comers’ should attend counseling sessions organized for them from time to time by the University staff.

### **Functions of Committee:**

1. Class wise Mentoring Cells, Anti ragging Sub committees (involving faculty, non teaching staff and students) and Anti Ragging Squads shall be formed in due course to distribute the responsibilities.
2. Oversee the procedure of obtaining undertaking from the students in accordance with the provisions;
3. Conduct workshops against ragging menace and orient the students;
4. To provide students the information pertaining to contact address and telephone numbers of the person(s) identified to receive complaints/distress calls;
5. To create awareness among the students about Anti ragging.

## ❖ **Prevention of caste based discrimination**

### **Introduction**

Discrimination on the basis of caste, locality, social / economical background or gender is prohibited at Colleges / Institutions / University. The Prevention of Caste based Discrimination Committee (PCDC) shall initiate continuous actions to ensure that no student / official / faculty member indulge in any kind of discrimination against any community or category of students, faculty or staff members. Committee shall sensitize officials / faculty members of the campus while dealing with such cases and see that the officials / faculty members desist from any act of discrimination against SC/ ST/ OBC students on grounds of their social origin.

### **Process and Functioning:**

1. The Committee will hear and address complaints regarding caste-based discrimination.
2. A complaint about discrimination or harassment as defined by the regulations may be made in writing by the student / Faculty or staff to the Prevention of Caste-based Discrimination Committee.
3. The written complaint should be submitted to the Chairman of the Prevention of Caste-based Discrimination Committee through the Principal or Head of Institution.
4. The complaint shall include sufficient details of the alleged act of discrimination or harassment.
5. On receipt of a written complaint, the Committee shall initiate the follow-up action including preliminary fact-finding enquiry.
6. The Committee will make recommendations to the Associate Deans / Principals, based on observations and examinations of complaints.
7. Based on the committee's recommendation, the Principal shall give guidance, counseling and resolve issues pertaining to the Caste Based Discrimination

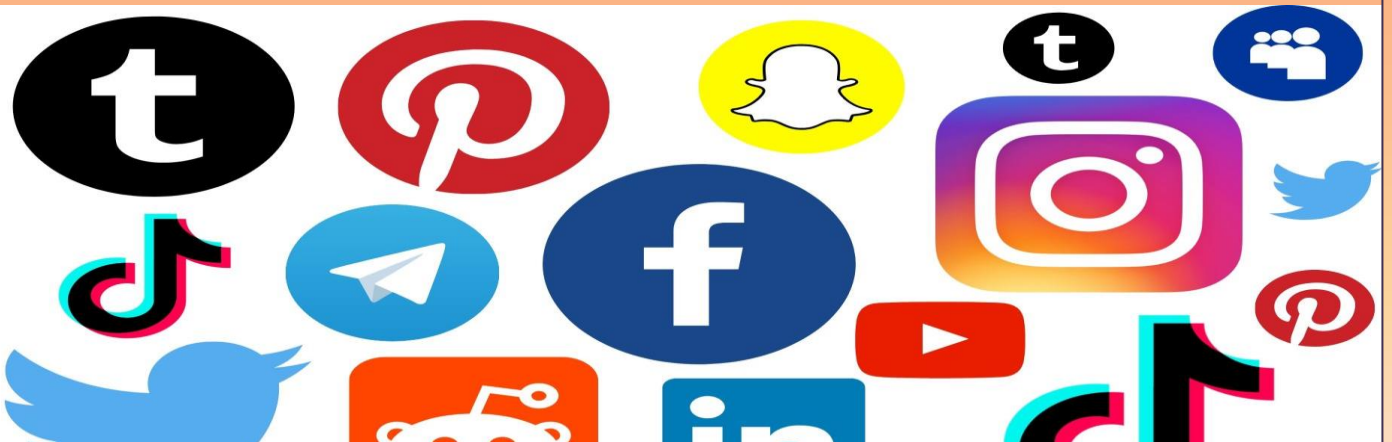
