- The footnotes should be in Times New Roman, font size 10 with single line spacing.
- One inch margins on all sides should be maintained
- Citation Style: Bluebook 20<sup>th</sup> Edition
- All Submissions must be the author's original and unpublished work. Plagriized submission will be disqualified
- Abstract& Full paper shall be accompanied by a brief profile of the author indicating his/her name of University/Organization/ Institution, Email ID.
- In case of co-authorship at least one author must attend the seminar to present the paper.
